POSITION: 1. FTE School Psychologist

JOB DESCRIPTION:

- Assess referred students through appropriate testing.
- Administer tests and recommend placement for all identified students by way of an Evaluation Team.
- Help identify within the school all types of disabled students within the rules and regulations of special education for the State of Montana.
- Maintain case records on all referred students.
- Confer with teachers and parents.
- Consult on special educational needs of emotionally disturbed, learning disabled, and other students as assigned.
- Attend all Evaluation Team meetings on placement of individual students who are disabled, emotionally disturbed or learning disabled.
- Interpret the school psychological services and test results to Evaluation Team.
- Prepare and submit required reports on special education children and special education programs, when requested.
- Assist with in-service training of school personnel.
- Keep abreast of new developments in the field.
- Assist with Child Find as required.

Qualifications:

- Current Montana Specialist Certificate and Endorsement in School Psychology.
- 3 years successful experience as a school psychologist preferred.
